Games - Learning different skills to improve throwing, catching and striking.

Athletics

Music:

'Music That Makes You Dance'
Learn to sing songs within a pitch range, understand tempo changes, mark the beat, and respond to different music styles.

D&T:

Sewing - making a felt butterfly.

RE:

Investigating Sikhism. How might a Sikh's beliefs influence their life?

Science:

Living things and their habitats
How animals are suited to their habitat.
The difference between things that are alive, dead and have never been alive
Food chains.

English:

Writing: Story writing, exploring setting and character description, and poetry.

Reading: comprehension skills including retrieval, inference and sequencing. Developing fluency and expression as we read aloud.

At home: Read a variety of text types and answer lots of questions about the book.
Remember to use clues in the text to explain characters' feelings and actions.

Computing:

Purple mash: Questioning and creating graphs.

Maths:

Measurement (length and height), Geometry (position and direction)
Revising all operations; addition, subtraction, division, multiplication.
Fractions of amounts and completing calculations with missing numbers.
Maths problems and reasoning style questions.
