

Up and away!

This half term, we are learning about flight. We'll think about the history of flight, explore different kinds of flying machines and invent our own. We will also be visiting the Duxford Imperial War Museum to learn more about aviation history!

Music:

Composing our own music, thinking about pitch, rhythm and types of instruments.

Art

Mixing and using paint. Colour! Primary and secondary colours. Creating artwork inspired by our learning about Sierra Leone.

Science:

A Habitat investigation. A minibeast hotel will be made and observations over time will reveal which habitat materials are popular with minibeasts.

History

Learning about the history of flight, particularly the Wright Brothers and Amy Johnson's record breaking flight to Australia.

Literacy:

Writing: exploring different genres of writing including poetry.
Grammar: adjectives, adverbs, conjunctions, openers and different types of punctuation.
Reading: Comprehension, Guided Reading, reading independently.
At home: Read a variety of text types and remember to ask lots of questions about the book, including characters feelings and actions to deepen understanding.
Practise spellings little and often!

PE:

Swimming - gaining confidence in the water, improving swimming strokes

Computing:

Creating digital artwork.

Maths:

Investigating time, statistics and strategies for the four operations. We will learn how to draw and interpret graphs and review the four operations in problem-solving questions.
