<p><u>Art</u></p> <p>Draw a scene or setting TWICE – for two different seasons. You may prefer to choose Summer and Winter so you can really show how the environment has changed. This setting could be where your adventure story takes place.</p>	<p><u>Writing – The Plan</u></p> <p>Plan an adventure story. 1 or 2 characters only Use the setting you have drawn in your ART option. Ensure that your story has: a beginning a middle an end</p>	<p><u>Writing – the story</u></p> <p>Follow your plan and describe what your characters are doing when the problem occurs. Explain how complex the problem is and describe fully how it is solved to create your ending. Don't forget full stops, capital letters and adjectives!</p>
<p><u>There, their and they're!</u></p> <p>Can you design a poster including three sentences showing the different meanings of these three homophones?</p>	<p><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Choose a book that you have read and either design a new front cover, draw a picture of the setting or draw and label your favourite character. (Remember to read a little every day too!)</p>	<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Create your own Times tables square. Fill in all the numbers accurately up to 12 times tables.</p>
<p><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Log into Times Tables Rock Stars and spend some time practising your times tables. Create a game to help you and your family practise them whilst having fun!</p>	<p><u>Reading</u></p> <p>Write a book review about a book you have read. Explain why you chose it, what genre of writing it is, what it was about and what you thought of it.
