Geography:

Environmental Changes: Considering how places change and the impact that human development and building can have on them, both positive and negative. Exploring how different groups of people might have different views on these changes.

RE:

Christian People: Exploring what Christians understand by 'saints' and why they are important for their faith.

Science:

States of Matter: Observing how materials change between solids, liquids and gases when they are heated or cooled. Understanding how the water cycle works.

Computing:

We will be looking at writing for different audiences using our iPads. We will be creating a news article.

French:

Je Me Presente (presenting myself).

English:

We will start our school year thinking about Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. We will be using direct speech to explore Charlie receiving the golden ticket before writing our own chapter about the chocolate factory. We will also write a non-fiction piece on the Water Cycle.
